Ashbrook by John Thomas 3mm TT gauge

This layout shows a fictional part of the M&SWJ in the 1950s, and has trains from the Midland and Southern regions, as well as from the Western region.

Barnwood Halt by Barnwood Model Railway Club 4mm OO gauge

Double Track Inner and Outer Loop. Outer loop is spectator driven. With two stations and village scene.

Weobley Marsh by Michael Bishop 4mm OO gauge

Fiddle yard and station with scenic background. Stock from BR steam to diesel transitional period or GWR steam.

3 Micro Layouts by Chris Sharp 4mm & 2mm OO

Three micro model railway layouts (Denton Wagon Works, Midsomer Parva & Cornish Clay Co) in two differing scales to demonstrate you don't need lots of space to own and run a model layout..

Queen's Street Yard by Gerald Maher 7mm O gauge

Compact O gauge working diorama of Edwardian period inner city goods yard. Built initially as at test track and developed into scenic display. Mainly based around LNWR and GER locomotives and rolling stock.

Hillside Siding by David Griffin 4mm 009/P4 gauge

Modern image plus preserved rail narrow gauge

Main Hall

Aimford End by Amelia Chamberlain 4mm OO gauge

A fictitious terminus of a branch line in the Cotswolds around the 1950s/60s in the western region

Oxford Road by Rich Papper 4mm OO gauge

Oxford Road is a fictitious setting somewhere in West London in the mid 1980s to early 1990s. The layout contains a small depot, fuelling point, engineers siding and short platform which sees a sporadic service of garishly painted Network South East first generation DMUs. The Bakerloo Line runs on a lower level beneath it and has its own separate station.

Somerset Lane by Tim Crockford 4mm OO gauge

The layout's name is a play on Devons Road, the first BR diesel depot, in east London. Somerset Lane is set in the 1950s and early 1960s, and features a variety of shunting and main-line locomotives that would have been seen around east London at that time.

Whitecliffe Quarry by Rob Mills 4mm OO gauge

Based on the branch to Whitecliffe Quarry near Coleford in the Forest of Dean.

Snug End by Phil Bird 3mm TT Finescale

This was inspired by a competition in the Hobby Magazine to build a diorama in 3 square feet (though for two small extensions are added). The design is based on the Inglenook Shunting Puzzle and was redrawn many times to get it to fit within the area whilst enabling shunting with a diesel up to the size of a class 20/25.

Vogelsbach by Eric Bird 3.5mm HOe gauge

A small layout loosely based on the Zillertalbahn narrow gauge terminus at Jenbach in Austria with a token standard gauge interchange platform. The main operating function will be using a mixture of modern Zillertalbahn and heritage rolling stock

Crossfield by Matthew Dixon 4mm OO gauge

This layout is accompanied by a bookstall with "The Forest Railway Stories" written by Matthew for children, and inspired by the Forest of Dean railway.

Forest of Dean Railway

Summer on Sodor by Hucclecote Railway Modellers 4mm 00 gauge

Displaying a variety of locos from the "Thomas the Tank Engine" books, and inviting you to take the controls.
